

Voting Early in WAIMAKARIRI

You do not have to wait until Election Day (23 September) to vote in the General Election. You can vote any time from **Monday 11 September** to **Saturday 23 September**. But only some polling places will be open early (and only at certain times). In **WAIMAKARIRI** those polling booths are...

Also, if you are not enrolled to vote yet, you can enrol and vote at the same time if you do it before Election Day

All early voting polling booths can take votes for the general electorate and the Maori electorate in that area.

There are also extra-special multi-electorate polling places where they have voting papers for more than one electorate. If you are not sure about your electorate or you are going with people who live in different electorates, go to one of these advance polling booths.
