YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO STOP UNSAFE WORK

If something feels wrong when you're on the job, step back and consider:

- Is there a serious risk here?
- Is it likely that myself or someone else will be harmed if I continue this work?

If you think so, STOP WORK immediately. Inform your manager, your Health & Safety representative, and your union delegate.

You can't get in trouble for stopping unsafe work to protect yourself, your colleagues, or anyone else on the worksite.
